THE NUMBER 47 SAYS IT ALL FOR THIS AWARD-WINNING GERMAN GIN; IT REFERS NOT ONLY TO THE ALCOHOL VOLUME BUT ALSO TO THE NUMBER OF BOTANICALS IT CONTAINS. SERVED WITH LAVENDER.

BOMBAY SAPPHIRE.....£3.50

THE TASTE OF BOMBAY IS CREATED THROUGH THE VAPOUR INFUSION OF IT'S 10 DELICATE BOTANICALS RESULTING IN A COMPLEX AROMATIC LIQUID THAT DELIVERS A BROADER, MORE BALANCED FLAVOUR. SERVED WITH LEMON.

PORTOBELLO ROAD.....£3.50

A TRADITIONAL LONDON DRY GIN, NO.171 HITS YOU WITH THE JUNIPER BEFORE SETTLING IN WITH BITTER CITRUS FLAVOURS AND THE DELICATE, SWEET TOUCH OF LIQUORICE. SERVED WITH LEMON & LIME

TANQUERAY NO. 10.....£3.50

SMOOTH, BALANCED AND CREAMY WITH A SUBTLE TASTE OF CORIANDER AND A BEAUTIFUL, BITING, DRY FINISH. SERVED WITH LEMON & LIME.

CAORUNN.....£3.50

THE WELL BALANCED FRUITY FLAVOURS OF THE CAORUNN MAKE THIS DRY, CRISP GIN EXCEEDINGLY DRINKABLE. SERVED WITH APPLE.

SIPSMITH.....£4.00

WITH TEN BOTANICALS AND WATER SOURCED FROM A THAMES SPRING. SIPSMITHS IS A TRADITIONAL LONDON DRY GIN WITH SUBTLE HINTS OF CITRUS AND SPICE THAT WORK HAND IN HAND WITH THE STRONG JUNIPER NOTES. SERVED WITH LEMON.

HENDRICKS.....£4.00

PRIDES ITSELF ON BEING THE WORLD'S MOST UNUSUAL GIN. THE FLAVOUR OF JUNIPER IS MILD, WITH ROSE AND CUCUMBER AS THE HIGH NOTES. SERVED WITH CUCUMBER & BLACK PEPPER.

NO.3 GIN.....£4.20

A BEAUTIFUL LOOKING GIN FROM BERRY BROS. THE NAME NO.3 REFERS TO THE ADDRESS OF BBR - NUMBER 3, ST JAMES'S STREET. WITH JUNIPER AT ITS HEART, IT'S ALSO MADE WITH THREE FRUITS AND THREE SPICES USING COPPER POT STILL. SERVED WITH ORANGE.

BATHTUB.....£4.50

THIS VERY HIGH QUALITY COPPER POT-STILL SPIRIT IS INFUSED WITH INGREDIENTS INCLUDING JUNIPER, ORANGE PEEL, CORIANDER, CINNAMON, CLOVES AND CARDAMON. SERVED WITH GRAPEFRUIT.

OPHIR.....£3.50

INDONESIAN CUBEB BERRIES, INDIAN BLACK PEPPER AND MORROCAN COIANDER ARE ALL USED IN THIS PLAYFULLY SPICED GIN. SERVED WITH CHILLI.

ADNAMS COPPER HOUSE.....£4.00

DISTILLED IN A BEER STRIPPING COLUMN, BEFORE BEING PUT THROUGH A HANDMADE COPPER POT STILL THIS GIN IS INFUSED WITH SIX BOTANICALS, INCLUDING JUNIPER, SWEET ORANGE AND HIBISCUS FLOWERS. SERVED WITH ORANGE.

PLYMOUTH.....£3.50

THIS HISTORIC BLACK FRIARS DISTILLERY GIN HAS DEEP EARTHY NOTES AND A WONDERFULLY FRESH JUNIPER AND LEMONY BITE. SERVED WITH LEMON.

THE BOTANIST ISLAY DRY GIN.....£4.20

THIS SPIRIT IS SATIN SMOOTH GLIDING OVER THE PALATE LIKE NO GIN YOU HAVE EVER TRIED BEFORE. A TOTALLY SEDUCTIVE EXPERIENCE. SERVED WITH LEMON AND THYME.

SHETLAND REEL GIN.....£4.50
 SHETLAND REEL GIN COMES TO US ALL THE WAY FROM UNST, ONE OF THE SHETLAND ISLANDS! MADE WITH A SPECIALLY DEvised RECIPE FEATURING 8 BOTANICALS, INCLUDING JUNIPER, CORIANDER SEED, ORRIS ROOT, CASSIA BARK, CITRUS PEEL AND APPLE MINT GROWN ON UNST. SERVED WITH BLACKBERRIES.

DAFFY'S SMALL BATCH GIN.....£4.50
 MADE WITH GRAIN SPIRIT FROM NORTHERN FRANCE, WHICH IS THEN DISTILLED USING A COPPER POT STILL. THE SCOTTISH DISTILLERS USE A SELECTION OF EIGHT BOTANICALS FOR DAFFY'S GIN, INCLUDING JUNIPER, LEBANESE MINT, CORIANDER, ANGELICA ROOT, SPANISH LEMON AND ORANGE PEELS, CASSIA BARK AND ORRIS ROOT. SERVED WITH STAR ANISE AND MINT.

FEW BARREL-AGED GIN.....£4.50
 THIS AMERICAN GIN TAKES ITS NAME IRONICALLY FROM THE INITIALS OF FRANCES ELIZABETH WILLARD, A KEY FIGURE IN THE TEMPERANCE MOVEMENT. SOME OF THE 11 BOTANICALS USED INCLUDE JUNIPER, CITRUS LEMON AND ORANGE PEEL, TAHITIAN VANILLA, CASSIA, GRAINS OF PARADISE AND HOME-GROWN HOPS. SERVED WITH VANILLA.

DOROTHY PARKER GIN.....£4.50
 A SPECTACULAR AMERICAN GIN, MADE WITH TRADITIONAL AND CONTEMPORARY BOTANICALS INCLUDING JUNIPER, ELDERBERRIES, CITRUS, CINNAMON, AND HIBISCUS PETALS. SERVED WITH OLIVES.

FILLIERS DRY GIN 28.....£4.20
 FILLIERS DRY GIN 28 USES 28 BOTANICALS IN ADDITION TO JUNIPER. IT IS A SMALL BATCH GIN CREATED IN COPPER STILLS WITH HINTS OF CORIANDER AND CARDAMOM. SERVED WITH CARROT.

SMOOTH AMBLER GREENBRIER.....£4.50
 AN INITIALLY CITRUS-LED GIN WITH SOFT JUNIPER CHARACTER IT'S PRODUCED BY SMOOTH AMBLER UP IN THE PICTURESQUE APPALACHIAN MOUNTAINS. BOTANICALS USED ARE JUNIPER, ORANGE PEEL, LEMON PEEL, CARDAMOM, CORIANDER, ANGELICA ROOT AND BLACK PEPPER. SERVED WITH CORIANDER & PEPPER.

BEEFEATER.....£3.50
 A SPICED, FRUITY GIN, FIRST MADE IN 1820 BY JAMES BURROUGHS. IT IS STILL, TO THIS DAY, MADE TO THE SAME RECIPE. SERVED WITH LIME

THE LONDON NO.1 ORIGINAL BLUE GIN£3.50
 A BEAUTIFUL QUADRUPLE-DISTILLED GIN FLAVOURED WITH BOTANICALS INCLUDING CINNAMON, ANGELICA, BERGAMOT AND GARDENIA AND HAS A AQUA BLUE TINT. SERVED WITH LEMON.

SIPSMITHS SLOE GIN.....£3.50
 A TRADITIONAL SLOE GIN FROM SIPSMITH, THE RESULT IS A TRULY HANDMADE SLOE GIN THAT IS SUBTLE, COMPLEX AND BURSTING WITH FLAVOUR. TASTES AMAZING IN CHAMPAGNE!

EDINBURGH GIN.....£4.00
 MADE BY SPENCERFIELD SPIRITS COMPANY, THIS DELICIOUS GIN IS DISTILLED IN EDINBURGH AND IS FLAVOURED WITH LOVELY BOTANICALS INCLUDING MILK THISTLE AND HEATHER. A VERY CREAMY LITTLE GIN. SERVED WITH GRAPE.

WILLIAM CHASE.....£4.20
 FLAVOURS OF JUNIPER, APPLE AND ELDERFLOWER ALONGSIDE SUBTLE CITRUS, THE FINISHED GIN IS DISTILLED OVER 100 TIMES WITH THE ENTIRE PROCESS TAKING OVER TWO YEARS FROM ORCHARD TO BOTTLE. SERVED WITH BASIL.

BULLDOG.....£3.50
 A DELICIOUS ENGLISH GIN MADE WITH POPPY, DRAGON EYE, LOTUS LEAVES, CITRUS, ALMOND, LAVENDER AND VARIOUS OTHER BOTANICALS. SERVED WITH LAVENDER & LIME.

DURHAM GIN.....£4.20
 DISTILLED IN A COLLIERY TOWN ON THE OUTSKIRTS OF DURHAM CITY, DURHAM GIN IS MADE WITH TEN BOTANICALS INCLUDING JUNIPER, CELERY SEED, ELDERFLOWER AND PINK PEPPERCORN AS WELL AS A SECRET MIX OF OTHER HERBS AND SPICES. SERVED WITH PINK PEPPERCORN.

DR. J'S GIN.....£4.20
 AN ARTISAN GIN FROM A VERY SMALL DISTILLER BASED IN THE VILLAGE OF DULLINGHAM IN CAMBRIDGESHIRE, MADE IN A HAND-BEATEN COPPER STILL CALLED MERLIN... NO REALLY IT IS. SERVED WITH TON BAY LEAF.

OLD ENGLISH GIN.....£4.20
OLDY-TIMEY GIN FROM HAMMER & SON, MADE WITH 11 BOTANICALS TO A RECIPE FROM 1783 AND DISTILLED IN THE OLDEST WORKING POT STILL IN ENGLAND! SERVED WITH MINT & LEMON.

ELEPHANT GIN.....£4.20
ELEPHANT DRY GIN IS DISTILLED USING 14 BOTANICALS THAT INCLUDE SOME RATHER UNUSUAL AFRICAN INGREDIENTS LIKE BAOBAB, THE BUCHU PLANT, DEVIL'S CLAW AND AFRICAN WORMWOOD. 15% OF THE PROFITS ELEPHANT GIN MAKE GO TO TWO AFRICAN ELEPHANT FOUNDATIONS TO SUPPORT THE PRESERVATION OF THE WILDLIFE. SERVED WITH CAPE GOOSEBERRIES.

BROCKMANS.....£4.50
THIS DELICIOUS GIN IS MADE WITH BULGARIAN CORIANDER, BLUEBERRIES AND BLACKBERRIES AS WELL AS BITTERSWEET VALENCIA ORANGE PEELS. THE RESULT IS WELL BALANCED AND FULL OF FLAVOUR. SERVED WITH BLACKBERRIES.

GORDON CASTLE GIN.....£4.50
SMALL-BATCH, HAND-CRAFTED GIN FROM THE GORDON CASTLE ALONG THE RIVER SPEY, FEATURING BOTANICALS GROWN IN THE ESTATE'S WALLED GARDEN. MINT, LAVENDER AND GOOSEBERRY ARE AMONG THE BOTANICAL SELECTION, GIVING THIS CRISP GIN A FLORAL, FRESH PALATE. SERVED WITH MINT.

MASONS DRY YORKSHIRE GIN.....£4.50
MASONS USE HARROGATE SPRING WATER FOR THEIR GINS ALONG WITH JUNIPER, A PROPORTION OF WHICH IS FROM THEIR OWN BUSHES, AND A COMBINATION OF SECRET BOTANICALS INCLUDING CITRUS. PRODUCED IN SMALL BATCHES, EACH BOTTLE HAS HAND WRITTEN BATCH AND BOTTLE NUMBERS. SERVED WITH ORANGE.

FILLIERS BARREL AGED.....£4.20
FEATURING 28 CAREFULLY CONSIDERED BOTANICALS AND THE ESSENTIAL JUNIPER BERRY, THIS GIN HAS BEEN MATURED FOR AROUND FOUR MONTHS IN LIMOUSIN BARRELS THAT HAVE A MEDIUM CHAR AND PREVIOUSLY HELD COGNAC. SERVED WITH GRAPE.

BROKER'S GIN.....£3.50
A FINE AND TASTY GIN WHICH HAS BEEN LAUDED BY CRITICS. BROKER'S IS MADE WITH HERBS, SPICES AND FRUITS IMPORTED FROM THREE CONTINENTS AND BLENDED TO BE EXTRA DRY. SERVED WITH LEMON AND LIME.

FIFTY POUNDS GIN.....£4.20
FIFTY POUNDS GIN IS DISTILLED IN SMALL QUANTITIES, AND IN SINGLE BATCHES. THE NAME COMES FROM THE TIME OF GEORGE II AND THE 1736 GIN ACT, WHEN A 50 POUND TAX WAS LEVIED ON THOSE WISHING TO PRODUCE AND SELL GIN. SERVED WITH ORANGE AND CORIANDER.

OLD TOM GIN.....£4.00
FRUITY AND SWEET ON THE NOSE WITH PRONOUNCED BOTANICAL NOTES AND A GOOD CITRUS ELEMENT. SERVED WITH ORANGE.

LITTLE BIRD LONDON DRY GIN.....£4.20
LITTLE BIRD IS MADE USING 10 CAREFULLY SELECTED BOTANICALS, RESULTING IN A WELL ROUNDED, CITRUS-FORWARD LONDON DRY GIN. A DYNAMIC NOSE, BUSTLING WITH GRAPEFRUIT, FOLLOWED BY A FRESH PALATE OF JUNIPER AND FURTHER CITRUS, COMPLIMENTED BY SPICY GINGER AND CORIANDER. SERVED WITH GRAPEFRUIT AND PEPPER.

EDEN MILL LOVE GIN.....£7.00
THIS LOVE GIN IS MADE WITH JUNIPER, CORIANDER SEED AND ANGELICA AS WELL AS RHUBARB ROOT, ROSE PETAL, GOJI BERRY, ELDERBERRY, MARSHMALLOW ROOT AND RASPBERRY LEAF! IT'S THEN INFUSED WITH HIBISCUS FLOWERS POST DISTILLATION. SERVED WITH PROSECCO.

EDEN MILL HOP GIN.....£4.50
THIS HOP GIN IS MADE WITH AUSTRALIAN GALAXY HOPS THAT ARE COLD COMPOUNDED POST DISTILLATION. A GIN FOR CRAFT BEER LOVERS (AS WELL AS GIN LOVERS). SERVED WITH SELECTED HOPS.

ROCK ROSE.....£4.50
THIS VERY NORTHERLY GIN FEATURES AN ALLURING BOTANICAL SELECTION INCLUDING LOCALLY HARVESTED RHODIOLA ROSEA, ROWAN BERRIES, SEA BUCKTHORN, BLAEBERRIES, VERBENA, CORIANDER SEED, CARDAMOM AND JUNIPER FROM TWO DIFFERENT COUNTRIES - ITALY AND BULGARIA.

COTSWOLDS DRY GIN.....£4.50
THIS IS THEIR COTSWOLDS DRY GIN. MADE WITH JUNIPER, CORIANDER AND ANGELICA ROOT MACERATED IN THEIR PURE WHEAT SPIRIT FOR 24 HOURS. FOLLOWING THIS, THEY ADD A BOTANICAL SELECTION INCLUDING BAY LEAF, GRAPEFRUIT, CARDAMOM SEED AND COTSWOLDS LAVENDER. SERVED WITH STARFRUIT.

MOMBASA CLUB LONDON DRY.....£4.20
MOMBASA CLUB LONDON DRY GIN TAKES ITS NAME FROM A PRIVATE SOCIAL CLUB FOUNDED IN 1885, WHOM IMPORTED GIN FROM ENGLAND TO THE ISLAND OF ZANZIBAR FOR THEIR MEMBERS TO ENJOY. IT'S MADE FOUR TIMES DISTILLED AND FEATURES A BOTANICAL SELECTION THAT INCLUDES JUNIPER, CASSIA BARK, ANGELICA ROOT, CORIANDER SEED, CLOVE AND CUMIN. SERVED WITH APPLE.

GORDON'S GIN 1970S.....£15.00
AN ABSOLUTE CLASSIC DRY GIN AND THIS ONE WAS DISTILLED IN THE 1970'S! GORDON'S IS ONE OF THE BEST SELLING SPIRITS IN THE WORLD. FIRST CREATED IN 1769, AND THE RECIPE HASN'T CHANGED SINCE! THIS IS A TRIPLE-DISTILLED GIN FLAVOURED WITH JUNIPER BERRIES, CORIANDER, ANGELICA, AND ONE OTHER BOTANICAL. THE ACTUAL RECIPE IS ONLY KNOWN TO A DOZEN PEOPLE!SERVED WITH TONIC.

PICKERING.....£4.00
PICKERING'S GIN IS DISTILLED IN EDINBURGH USING A RECIPE FOUND ON A PIECE OF PAPER WHICH WAS WRITTEN IN 1947. AFTER FINELY-TUNING THE INGREDIENTS, FEATURING BOTANICALS LIKE JUNIPER, LEMON, LIME, CORIANDER, ANISE, ANGELICA, CARDAMOM, CLOVE AND FENNEL.

SIPPING GINS

STEAMPUNK.....£4.20
SMOOTH ON THE PALATE. WITH JUNIPER, CARDOMOM AND CITRUS MELTING TOGETHER IN PERFECT HARMONY.

LANGTONS NO.1.....£4.00
LANGTONS USES WATER FILTERED THROUGH ANCIENT SLATE BENEATH THE MOUNTAIN OF SKIDDAW IN THE LAKE DISTRICT. UTILISING LAKELAND INGREDIENTS SUCH AS LOCAL OAK BARK BLEND WHERE POSSIBLE, A TOTAL OF 11 BOTANICALS ARE USED.

ST. GEORGE BOTANIVORE GIN.....£4.50
AN AMERICAN CRAFT GIN WITH 19 DIFFERENT BOTANICALS, INCLUDING ANGELICA ROOT, BAY LAUREL, CORIANDER, SEVILLE ORANGE PEEL, STAR ANISE AND JUNIPER BERRIES, AMONG OTHERS.

CREAM GIN.....£4.50
THIS CREAM GIN HAS BEEN COLD-DISTILLED USING FRESH CREAM AS A BOTANICAL (THE EQUIVALENT OF 100ML CREAM PER BOTTLE!), TO CAPTURE THE FRESH FLAVOUR OF THE CREAM IN A PERFECTLY CLEAR SPIRIT.

A BIT ABOUT GIN.....

GIN AND ITS LOWLANDS COUSIN GENEVER ARE WHITE SPIRITS THAT ARE FLAVORED WITH JUNIPER BERRIES AND BOTANICALS. THE SPIRIT BASE OF GIN IS PRIMARILY GRAIN (USUALLY WHEAT OR RYE), WHICH RESULTS IN A LIGHT-BODIED SPIRIT.

BOTANICALS CAN INCLUDE ANISE, ANGELICA ROOT, CINNAMON, ORANGE PEEL, CORIANDER, AND CASSIA BARK. ALL GIN AND GENEVER MAKERS HAVE THEIR OWN SECRET COMBINATION OF BOTANICALS, THE NUMBER OF WHICH CAN RANGE FROM AS FEW AS FOUR TO AS MANY AS 47.

THE ORIGINS OF GIN ARE RATHER MURKY. IN THE LATE 1580S A JUNIPER-FLAVORED SPIRIT OF SOME SORT WAS FOUND IN HOLLAND BY BRITISH TROOPS WHO WERE FIGHTING AGAINST THE SPANISH IN THE DUTCH WAR OF INDEPENDENCE. THEY GRATEFULLY DRANK IT TO GIVE THEM WHAT THEY SOON CAME TO CALL "DUTCH COURAGE" IN BATTLE.

TODAY, THE JUNIPER FLAVOURED LIQUOR IS ENGLAND'S UNOFFICIAL NATIONAL SPIRIT AND WE WOULD AGREE THAT THERE ARE FEW THINGS MORE REFRESHING THAN SIPPING ON A CRISP GIN & SPARKLING TONIC SO GO AHEAD, ENJOY IT.
